

PETERBOROUGH POOL ASSOCIATION KNOCK OUT COMPETITION FORMATS.

PPA RULES TEAM KO CUP / PLATE

Thursday PPA League : **Best of 10 frames, 2 sessions of 5 singles.** Away team order to be changed in the 2nd session e.g. 1st Session 1-2-3-4 -5, 2nd Session 2-3-1-5-4
The break is decided by the toss of a coin
8.30.pm Start.

If after 10 Frames the result is 5-5, each captain must “nominate” a player to play a deciding frame.
The player nominated must have played previously and cannot be a reserve.

PPA RULES INDIVIDUAL KO COMPETITIONS

Singles & Captains

Best of 5 frames up to and including the Quarte Finals and then **the best of 7 frames** thereafter.

Doubles

Best of 3 frames up to and including the Quarte Finals and then **the best of 5 frames** thereafter.

Triples

Best of 9 frames. 3 Sessions of 3 Singles. Away teams order to be changed in the 2nd and 3rd Sessions. E.g. 1st Season 1-2-3, 2nd Session 2-3-1, 3rd Session 3-1-2.

Teams will consist of 3 Minimum or 4 Maximum players. Any 3 players from the 4 registered can play.

Once a player has been replaced by a reserve no further changes will be allowed.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY & EXCLUSION FOR ALL PPA KO COMPETITIONS

Player Eligibility :

Prior to the Quarter Finals of individual competitions, players **must have signed a Score Card at least once, either as a reserve or player, in 50% of the respective league fixtures.** Any player failing to have participated 50% will be subject to automatic disqualification.

If a team withdraws, or is expelled, from the league, any players from that team **will cease to be eligible to play in PPA League Competitions.** The Committee may, at its discretion, consider applications for an individual to continue in competitions, subject to a transfer request. The Captain will not be allowed to continue in the Captain's Cup Competition. Where possible, players should submit an email address for information to be sent to them for their next rounds.

PLAYERS WHO TRANSFER TEAMS IN THE SAME LEAGUE WILL BE CLASSED AS CUP TIED IN ANY TEAM KO CUP / PLATE.

NO NEW PLAYERS CAN BE SIGNED TO PLAY ON THE NIGHT OF A TEAM KO CUP / PLATE FIXTURE.

Organisation of Games

It is the DUTY of both players/teams to contact each other and agree a mutual date (BEFORE THE DATE OF THE DEAD LINE) for the game to be played. If no contact can be made or a difficulty arises, they are to contact the Competitions Secretary for adjudication.

No games can be automatically claimed by default.

Reporting Results

Individual Winners must **text the result to , James Cruickshank, Competitions Secretary on Mob No. 07401 315003** and Winning Team captains must **text the result to , Vanessa Knappert, Competitions Secretary on Mob No. 07401 315009** , as soon as the match has been played.

Team KO Results Cards are to be posted to reach Vanessa Knappert, Competitions Secretary by the first Post on the Monday (for Thursdays league) following the game. It is the responsibility of the WINNING team to collect & post result card to the **correct address** on time.

Any results that are not received by closing date deadline will be deemed un-played and all parties will be eliminated.
